The OGLCA invites producers, producer groups and organizations to submit applications for the Oklahoma Grazing Lands Grant Program. This grant program is administered through the OGLCA with funds provided through a cooperative agreement with the Natural Resources Conservation Service.

The Program is designed to support the OGLCA efforts to provide Oklahoma's Grazing Lands owners and managers with knowledge needed to make sound decisions concerning grazing lands conservation. This is accomplished through projects that provide opportunities for demonstration and education of grazing lands principles, new technology, concepts and research which can help landowners manage their resources in a manner that is both economically efficient and ecologically sustainable.

Attached is an overview and explanation of the Grant Program and applications for three types of grants available:

1. Demonstration Projects
2. Educational Projects
3. Producer Educational Scholarships.

Applications must be submitted by January 24th, 2003 for consideration this year. The OGLCA will review applications and notify applicants by February 28th, 2003. Projects can begin following approval.
