SUBJECT: SPA - Progress Reporting in PRMS (Pest/Brush Management)

Purpose: To provide guidance on reporting practices Pest Management (595) and Brush Management (314) in PRMS.

Expiration Date: September 30, 2003

Based on the recommendation of a subcommittee of the Quality Leadership Team (QLT), the following policy will be implemented immediately.

For PRMS reporting only, practice code 595 (Pest Management) may also be reported when practice 314 (Brush Control) is applied. This change is due to changes being made to the national practice standard for Pest Management. The same wording will be applied to the "Purpose" in the Oklahoma standard the next time it is revised.

This should in no way change other programs or activities. When cost share is involved, staff must be careful that duplicate payments (Pest Management and Brush Management) are not made for the same acres.
