SUBJECT: FNM – 2nd Annual National Tribal Soil and Water Conservation District and/or Tribal Conservation Advisory Council Conference – December 6-10, 2004

Purpose: To inform employees of the 2nd National Tribal Districts and Conservation Advisory Councils Conference.

Expiration Date: September 30, 2004

Action Required By: October 5, 2004

The National Tribal Districts and Conservation Advisory Councils Conference will be held in Las Vegas, Nevada, from December 6–10, 2004. The theme for the conference is “Coming Together” and the focus of the conference is to bring tribes, tribal conservation districts, tribal partners, agencies, and organizations together to share accomplishments, opportunities, and programs that will promote preservation of American Indian natural resources and land. It is being co-hosted by the Indian Nations Conservation Alliance (INCA) and the Oklahoma Tribal Conservation Advisory Council (OTCAC).

As in past training conferences, the following attendance categories will receive consideration on a "government time/government expense" basis:

- Receiving an award, citation, or commendation
- Receiving a scholarship
- Presenting a topical paper or poster
- Member of the Chief's Staff
- Training (providing or fulfilling a training need)

Requests for approval to attend the conference on "government time/government expense" or "government time only" are to be approved by supervisors and routed through the appropriate SLT member, then forwarded to my office for final approval. An SCS-FNM-72 will be compiled and forwarded for national approval. (Meeting information is attached.)
